## Where Kids Learn About A Special Kind Of Love

Camp Agapé is open to those children entering kindergarten through those exiting grade eight. Sessions run Monday-Friday, 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Extra early (6:00 to 8:30 am) and early (7:30 to 8:30 am) drop-off, late (3:30 to 5:00 pm) and extra late (3:30 to 6:00 pm) pick-up are also available for an additional fee. See details on next page. Designed with the family in mind, we think family vacations and other family events are important, so we offer one week and partial week registration (minimum of 4 days per week).

**Academic Coaching is provided three days a week to help students stay sharp over the summer or significantly improve their skills if needed. (See back page.)**

### Camp Philosophy

The name Agapé was chosen for our camp because it is the Greek word used to describe God's unconditional, forgiving love. Our counselors are trained to express this to your children. Also, your children will learn more about this love in our song and story times. A full program of fun and recreation, singing, storytelling, Bible time, nature study, etc. will be provided for your children. Each week of programming is customized so that no session is alike. Your children may attend as many weeks as needed without fear of repetition. We usually go swimming twice a week, and visit a park, forest preserve, or nature center twice a week. Plus there is a weekly field trip, usually held on Wednesdays (see schedule). Each afternoon after their outings, campers will rotate between various activities and arts and crafts centers. A staff ratio of 1 to 6 will be maintained to ensure individualized attention. For various activities, children will be divided into three camper groups: entering grades K-2, entering grades 3-5, and entering grades 6-8. At other times, the children will be in small groups with their counselor.

### Camp Agapé Teaches Christ-Centered Morals

With the stresses on the family, the shortage of positive role models, and the slipping of moral standards in today's world, our children face a growing list of obstacles. To enable children to successfully face the challenges of today's world and break the power of peer pressure, they need education with moral values. Camp Agapé features teaching on moral values derived from the Biblical description of God's unconditional love:

### Registration Info

Children can register for one week at a time, payable the first morning of the first week of attendance OR all 10 weeks. Payment for the next consecutive week must be made at the time of the last pick-up of the previous week. A \$5 late fee will be assessed if payment is made after this time.

- There is a one-time non-refundable registration fee of \$30.
- Cost per week is \$80.
- Partial week fee (4 days minimum) is \$68
- The fee for your last week of camp is due at the time of registration.
- There will be extra fees for weekly field trips. (See field trip list for details.)
- The registration form, medical form, pick-up form and payment should be turned in as soon as possible.
- **Scholarship help is available** for campers who qualify for free or reduced lunches at school. Ask for details and application.

**If your plans should change after registration, one-week written notice is needed to cancel dates or you will be charged for those dates.**
